The \$1,000 yearly scholarship for musicians or singers is to be used for their study or for projects related to Irish instrumental music or song. Applicants may be of any age or ethnic background and need not be residents of the Milwaukee area.

The Scholarship Committee anticipates announcing the Edward J. Ward Irish Music Scholarship recipient during Milwaukee Irish Fest in August.

Winners will be given \$500 in August of the award year. The remaining \$500 will be awarded only upon the committee's receipt of the grantee's report, including evidence (such as receipts and registration forms) that the project was completed.
